Privacy Settings

For each question, you'll see visibility options: **Everyone**, **All Members**, **Friends**, or **Only Me**. Some questions have a green **Change** button, allowing you to modify who can see your responses. Remember, this is a private community, and no information is available to the public. We recommend thinking carefully about what you share. Avoid posting private information like your phone number or email address. Take time to decide what details you're comfortable letting others see

Required Information

Four required questions must be filled out to save your responses.

- 1. Name
- Why it's required: Identify you on the platform.
- 2. Current Location
- How to answer: Start typing your address or city, then select the correct option from the drop-down menu.
- Why it's required: Helps match you with nearby housemates and ensures accurate filtering.
- 3. Birth Date
- Note: Only your age will be displayed to other members.
- Why it's required: Age is important for matching preferences and compatibility.
- 4. Desired Housing Location
- **How to answer:** Similar to "Current Location," type your address or city and select from the drop-down menu.

• Why it's required: Ensures your housing needs are matched with potential housemates in your preferred area.

Optional Profile Details

1. Primary Contact Name

• Note: This can be your name or the name of the person managing your account.

2. Primary Contact Email

• Used for communication and account management.

3. Contact Phone Number

• Helps facilitate direct communication when needed.

4. Gender

Provides additional context for matching with housemates.

5. About Me

- Note: This section is visible to other members when they view your profile.
- How to use: Share details about yourself, like your personality, lifestyle, or background.

Examples of "About Me":

Example 1: I'm a kind and easygoing person who loves spending time with animals and enjoying the little things in life. Sundays are special to me because I get to cook healthy meals and share them with my church community. I also have a creative side and love decorating my home for every holiday—it always puts me in a festive mood!

Example 2: I'm a laid-back person who loves spending time both online and in person playing fantasy video games with my friends. I also enjoy hanging out at the YMCA swimming and trying out new activities. When I'm relaxing at home, there's nothing better than a good action TV show and some popcorn—or maybe a pizza night!

6. Hobbies & Interests

- Note: This section is visible to other members when they view your profile.
- How to use: List activities or passions that matter to you.

Examples of "Hobbies & Interests":

Example 1: I love nature and animals, so volunteering at the local shelter is something I truly enjoy. Cooking is one of my favorite activities, especially trying out healthy recipes. I'm also a big fan of mystery books and belong to a book club that meets monthly. When I'm not busy, you can find me streaming drama shows or visiting the local petting zoo.

Example 2: Fantasy video games are my favorite pastime, especially when I can team up with my gaming friends online. I like staying active, so I spend a lot of time at the YMCA swimming and exploring other activities. Watching action-packed TV shows, especially classics from the '80s and '90s, is another way I like to unwind. And of course, I never say no to a great pizza night!

7. Community Involvement

• Note: Highlight any volunteer work, clubs, or other community-related activities.

Examples of "Community Involvement":

Example 1: Giving back is important to me. I help prepare meals for my church congregation on Sundays and volunteer regularly at an animal shelter. I'm also part of a local book club where we read and discuss mysteries, which is a fun way to connect with others.
